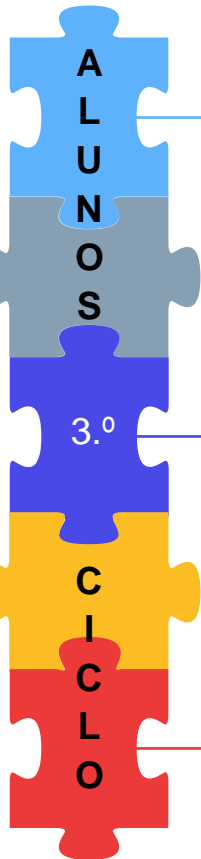

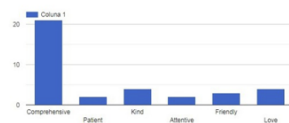
Planos de aula: Tolerância Discriminação Migrantes e refugiados
